**Title: Kappa Chapter Project- Feeding Benton County**

In November 2023, Kappa Chapter had 2 ways that we were able to serve the people and families of Benton County. First we visited the Second Harvest Food Bank where we sorted through 1,820 pounds of frozen food that had been donated by Wal-Mart. That turns out to be 1,517 individual meals or enough to feed a family of 4 (2 adults & 2 children) for 379 meals. Next we prepared and served a hot meal at a Second Harvest Service Site, The Christ Cafe in Camden, TN. There we served 101 people in need from our community either in person or by delivering some meals to those who are unable to get out to get the meal.
