The Impact of Clean Water on Education

An Alpha Chapter program “*The Impact of Clean Water on Education*” was presented virtually by Krista Dover, Director of Clean Water for the World. She’s a Tennessee native who now lives in Guatemala. She had impressive statistics on how a single water purification system about the size of a large suitcase, costing between \$1K and \$2K, depending on whether it’s electric or solar, can improve the whole community’s gastrointestinal health, which in turn improves school attendance, which in turn improves grades and student accomplishments. The water purification systems are placed almost exclusively in schools around the world and serve up to 600 people.
